

## The Loppet Foundation Habitat Restoration Lead Volunteer Role

**Job Summary:** This role works with the LEAP Land Use committee as well as our habitat restoration consultants from NatureWerks, to plan for and lead volunteer habitat restoration events.

## Habitat Restoration Lead is responsible for the following:

- Work with the LEAP Land Use Committee on planning, organization and coordination of Tuesday evening volunteer habitat restoration events.
- Step in as lead for some Tuesday evening volunteer habitat restoration events. This includes:
  - o Sending reminder/details email to registered participants the morning prior to event
  - o Gathering tools, gloves, snacks, signage for the night and putting away when done.
  - Facilitating the event but greeting volunteers, engaging throughout, and providing some knowledge and plan for the evening
  - o Communicating after the event what was worked on/accomplished
- Possibly coordinate and lead other habitat restoration volunteer events outside of Tuesday evenings.

We recognize the need for a diverse workforce and understand that traditionally underrepresented communities must be centered in the work we do. As a Foundation, we are committed to building a blended team that reflects the community we serve. Hence, we strongly encourage BIPOC, Indigenous and Queer-identified individuals to apply.
