Job Summary: Assist and support the traffic and parking logistics at the event. We utilize three main lots for our events and have a shuttle system for our larger signature events. Time commitment is approximately 4-6 hours per day of an event with a 1:1 call or emailing with the Event Director prior to the event.

Parking and Transportation volunteers are responsible for the following:

- Working with volunteers and supervising the execution of parking and traffic logistics at different parking locations
- Working directly with the shuttle drivers to ensure they are familiar with the route and overall logistics of the event
- Managing, directing, and communicating with Parking and Transportation volunteers to ensure smooth event operations.

We recognize the need for a diverse workforce and understand that traditionally underrepresented communities must be centered in the work we do. As a Foundation, we are committed to building a blended team that reflects the community we serve. Hence, we strongly encourage BIPOC, Indigenous and Queer-identified individuals to apply.
